Dear Parents,

The end of the year is right around the corner, and I wanted to send you a note on what our schedule looks like. In the past, students took part in an end of the year trip. However, this year we have decided to move in a different direction with our use of our school funds and focus more on short term goals for our students. The money is now mainly being invested in supporting our Positive Behavior Intervention System (PBIS). Examples include:

1. Weekly incentives at lunch for purchase with Bee tickets (PBIS currency). Items include ice cream, hot chocolate, popsicles, and lemonade.
2. Donuts for entire homeroom with five days of perfect attendance for the class.
3. Purchase of Figaro's Pizza to be delivered to students at lunch for 250 Bee tickets.
4. Upgraded Bee Ticket store and prizes to be purchased with Bee tickets.
5. Off campus lunch free of charge for students meeting a certain criteria for tardiness, attendance, and behavior every six weeks.
6. Valuable prizes to be auctioned off throughout the year using Bee tickets.
7. End of the year Homeroom competitions with prizes.
8. End of the year talent show with prizes.
9. End of the year school carnival with games and prizes.
10. School wide BBQ.
11. These funds are also going towards upgrading our break time activities with new play equipment and basketball hoops.

We understand change is hard, but by focusing on short term goals and enhancing our PBIS model, we will see more positive outcomes for our students versus an end of the year trip.

There are several end of the year events you are invited to; our talent show, BBQ (must prepay by May 31st), and school carnival. Parents are also welcome to attend our homeroom competitions. On Thursday, June 14th our 8th graders will be headed to the high school at the end of the day for an award presentation (department awards), prizes, farewell slideshow, and dessert. Parents are encouraged to come to this event in the high school auditorium; this is a casual event. Following our 8th grade activities, students will be able to leave with their parents to begin their hard earned summer break!
